All areas of the venue are flat, but it is worth noting that most of the venue is grassed. This may cause difficulty for those who are wheelchair-bound or using a mobility scooter, especially if it has rained in the past few days. Make sure to keep an eye on the weather in the days leading up to the Field Days to plan your visit best!
